A journey with an unexpected destination



- ▶ Where did we start out from?
 - ▶ We need to support users who lack self-regulated learning and digital competence
 - ▶ *Let's give them a tutor and 1:1 sessions*
- ▶ Where did we end up at?
 - ▶ Little interest in 1:1 tutor support but still a significant impact
 - ▶ *Interesting dynamics at play that allow course providers to tweak their course deliveries for greater impact*
